Larcenies from Vehicles Investigation

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspects responsible for multiple larcenies from vehicles which occurred off of King Street.

On October 17, 2013, officers were dispatched to the area of 1200 block of North King Street and 1000 block of Jonquil Lane in reference to larcenies from vehicles. The investigation revealed the suspects rummaged through the vehicles and removed electronics, U.S. Currency and credit cards. It appears that there was no forced entry into the vehicles and that most vehicles had been left unsecured. The picture below is one of four suspects who were involved in these incidents. The photograph was captured from a surveillance camera in the gated community where the larcenies took place. There is no additional suspect information on the other three suspects involved.



The Hampton Police Division encourages all citizens to secure their vehicles and to remove items of value from plain view from inside of their vehicle. The Division will have increased patrols in and around these areas to maintain a high visibility.

Crime Line callers remain anonymous and never appear in court. If a Crime Line call results in an arrest, the caller is eligible for a reward up to \$1,000.00.
