Fatal Crash Investigation: West Pembroke Avenue and Greenbriar Avenue

The Hampton Police Division is currently investigating a fatal crash that occurred on November 7, 2013.

At 8:21 a.m., Hampton Police Communications received a w911 call in reference to a two vehicle crash at the intersection of West Pembroke Avenue and Greenbriar Avenue. Officers and members of the Hampton Fire and Rescue Division arrived on scene and located an adult female deceased on scene.

The preliminary investigation has revealed that a 2000 Chevrolet sedan attempted to make a left turn from Greenbriar Avenue to travel West on Pembroke Avenue when it collided with a Chevrolet work van that was traveling East on Pembroke Avenue. The driver of the Chevrolet sedan was pronounced deceased on scene and her front seat passenger was transported by ambulance to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries. There were no additional injuries. The crash is being investigated by members of the Hampton Police Division Fatal Crash Team.

The cause of the crash is still under investigation. As additional information becomes available it will be released. The victim's identification will be released once the next of kin has been notified.
