Multiple Larceny from Vehicle Investigations

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect(s) responsible for multiple larcenies from vehicles which occurred in the Northampton section of the city.

During the early morning hours on March 3, 2014, officers discovered that an unknown suspect(s) had broken into nine vehicles in the Northampton section of the City. The investigation revealed that the suspect(s) used an unknown object to break either the side or rear window of four of the vehicles in order to gain access into them. The other vehicles had been left unlocked. After getting into the vehicles, the suspect(s) took electronics and other miscellaneous items before fleeing the area in an unknown direction and by unknown means. No arrests have been made and there is currently no suspect information.
