Suspect Arrested for Inappropriate Communication with a Juvenile

The Hampton Police Division has arrested **Kimberlee A. Dietz** in connection with an investigation involving alleged inappropriate communication with a child by means of an electronic device which occurred in March 2014.

On April 7, 2014, **Kimberlee A. Dietz**, a 31-year-old Hampton woman who resides in the 200 block of Shawen Drive, was arrested and charged with one count of Felony, Use of a Communications Device to Facilitate certain Offenses Involving a Juvenile.

The investigation revealed, on March 2, 2014, officer's responded to a residence located in the Chesapeake sector of the city in reference to a suspicious activity complaint. The suspect, a former Hampton City School employee, allegedly had inappropriate communication by means of an electronic device with a Hampton male juvenile attending a City of Hampton school in March 2014. Ms. Dietz is currently in the custody of the Hampton Sherriff's Office.
