Bank Robbery Investigation: 2000 Block of Kecoughtan Road

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect responsible for a bank robbery that occurred on March 28, 2014.

At 2:54 p.m., Public Safety Communications received a panic alarm from the Wells Fargo located in the 2000 block of Kecoughtan Road. Upon officer's arrival, they discovered that the suspect entered the business and gave a note to the teller demanding money. After taking an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency from the business, the suspect fled on foot. He was last seen running on Chesterfield Road towards Victoria Boulevard. At the time when the robbery occurred there were patrons inside of the business, however there were no injuries.

The suspect is described as a black male in his forties. He was last seen wearing all dark clothing and a blue baseball cap.
