UPDATE- Suspects Arrested in Shooting Investigation: 3800 block of Kecoughtan Road

The Hampton Police Division has identified and arrested multiple individuals in connection with a shooting that occurred on April 25, 2014.

At 5:43 p.m., Public Safety Communications received an e911 call in reference to a shots fired complaint in the parking lot of the Kecoughtan Shopping Center which is located in the 3800 block of Kecoughtan Road. Upon officer's arrival, they discovered evidence of a shooting, which included one unoccupied business (JCS Insurance) being struck. At 6:02 p.m., a 24-year-old male and a 21-year-old male, both of whom reside in Hampton, were admitted into a local hospital suffering from gunshot wounds. The 24-year-old sustained a gunshot wound to his lower torso and has since been released from the hospital. The 21-year-old sustained a gunshot wound to his upper torso and remains hospitalized in stable condition. At 7:42 p.m., a 20-year-old Hampton man, was admitted to a local hospital with a gunshot wound to the upper torso and has since been released.

The investigation has revealed that the individuals involved in this incident, whom were all known to each other, were occupying a GMC Envoy when an altercation ensued and the shooting occurred. The investigation thus far has indicated that there are narcotic overtones associated with this incident.

On April 25, 2014, two individuals were arrested in connection with this incident. **Raghib Ismail Brooks**, a 23 year-old Hampton man who resides in the 100 block of Barksdale Drive, has been arrested in connection with this incident and has been charged with one count of Aggravated Malicious Wounding, one count of Maiming, one count of Use of a Firearm in the Commission of a Felony, one count of Possession with the Intent to Distribute Narcotics and one count of Discharging a Firearm in a Public Place. As the investigation continued, **Calvin Leon Hockaday Jr.**, a 24-year-old Hampton man who resides in the 1st block of Spur Court was arrested in connection with this incident. He has been charged with one count of Robbery and one count of Conspiracy to Commit Robbery. Both suspects are in the custody of the Hampton Sheriff's Office.

A third suspect, **Benny Garcia Jr.**, a 20-year-old male who resides in the 3900 block of Sunny Park Court Lake in Ridge, Virginia, has been identified in connection with this incident. He currently has warrants on file for one count of Robbery, one count of Use of a Firearm in the Commission of a Felony and one count of Conspiracy to Commit Robbery.
