Suspects in Custody in Shooting Investigation: 800 Block of Lasalle Avenue

The Hampton Police Division has two suspects in custody in connection with a shooting that occurred on July 17, 2014.

At 1:18 p.m., Public Safety Communications received multiple calls in reference to a shots fired complaint in the 800 block of Lasalle Avenue. Upon officers arrival they located two businesses within Queens Plaza (Adams Pawn Shop & Lift Jesus Higher Ministries) that had been struck by suspected gunfire. In addition to the businesses an occupied residence in the 900 block of Queen Street was also struck. There were no injuries at either location.

Descriptions of the alleged suspects were quickly disseminated to arriving officers. An extensive foot pursuit ensued which resulted in the apprehension of the two suspects allegedly in connection with this incident. The circumstances and motive continue to be under investigation and as more information becomes available it will be released.

The suspect's names and mug shots will be provided once warrants have been obtained along with their corresponding charges.
