Larcenies from Vehicles Investigation

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect(s) in connection with multiple larcenies from vehicles which occurred in the Foxhill section of the city during the early morning hours of July 31, 2014.

At 3:48 a.m., officers responded to the area of East Little Back River Road and Cannonball Run in reference to suspicious persons attempting to enter parked vehicles. Prior to officer's arrival the suspicious persons had left the area. Officers canvassed the area and discovered entry had been gained to seven vehicles in the area of the 1st block of Cannonball Run and the 700 block of East Little Back River Road. Once inside the vehicles the suspect(s) removed electronics, U.S. currency and additional miscellaneous items. The investigation revealed that **all** the vehicles where entry had been gained had been left **unlocked**. There are no complete suspect descriptions available for dissemination.

The Hampton Police Division would like to remind citizens to secure their vehicles and remove items of value in plainview.
