Suspect Arrested in Burglary & Vandalism Investigations

The Hampton Police Division has arrested and charged **Dimitri Lorenzo Bynum** in reference to Burglary and Vandalism incidents that occurred on September 24 & 26, 2014.

On September 26, 2014 at 5:50 a.m., Hampton officer's responded to the W&W Market located in the 900 block of West Pembroke Avenue in reference to an alarm activation. Upon officer's arrival, they observed an individual leaving the business and a short foot pursuit ensued. The suspect, **Dimitri Lorenzo Bynum**, a 20-year-old Hampton man who resides in the 1100 block of LaSalle Avenue was quickly apprehended without incident. The investigation revealed that entry into the business had been gained through a window and an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency, electronic equipment and cigarettes had been removed.

Further investigation revealed that on September 24, 2014, Mr. Bynum allegedly attempted to gain entry into an Automatic Teller Machine (ATM) at the Bayport Credit Union located in the 2300 block of Cunningham Drive. The investigation revealed that the suspect made multiple attempts to gain entry to the ATM. After not being able to gain entry he fled the scene. Mr. Bynum was subsequently charged with one count of Burglary, one count of Grand Larceny, one count of Destruction of Private Property, one count of Possession of Burglary Tools and one count of Destruction of Private Property in relation to both incidents.
