Robbery from Business Investigation: 2300 Block of West Mercury Boulevard

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect in connection with a business robbery that occurred on October 26, 2014.

At 6:52 p.m., Hampton Police responded to the CVS pharmacy, located in the 2300 block of West Mercury Boulevard, in reference to a robbery from business complaint. The investigation revealed that a single suspect armed with a firearm entered the business and demanded narcotics. After receiving the narcotics, the suspect fled the business. When the robbery occurred there were no patrons inside of the business and there were no injuries to any of the employees.

The suspect is described as: an African-American male with a light complexion, 5'07"-6'00", 150-165 pounds. He was last seen wearing black pants, a gray short sleeve shirt with a patch on the left sleeve, white baseball hat and he utilized a white t-shirt to conceal his identity.
