Commercial Burglaries to Hampton Schools

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect(s) in connection with multiple school burglaries.

Between December 1, 2014 and December 9, 2014, Hampton City Schools has experienced five burglaries to the following buildings: Hampton High School, Bridgeport Academy, Andrews School, Phenix School, and Davis Middle School.

The preliminary investigation revealed, that afterschool hours, unknown suspect(s) gained access to the schools by forcing entry through a window. Once inside, the suspect(s) removed several Apple MacBook laptops, Apple Desktop computers, and an Apple iPad.
