Death Investigation ruled Homicide: 2000 Block of Seldendale Drive

The Hampton Police Division is currently investigating a homicide that occurred on January 28, 2015.

On January 28, 2015 at 7:04 a.m., Public Safety Communications received a medical call for service in the 2000 block of Seldendale Drive in reference to a 2-year-old Hampton female that was unresponsive. Members of the Hampton Fire and Rescue Division responded to the home and transported the juvenile to a local hospital, where she was pronounced deceased at 8 a.m.

Hampton Police Detectives immediately began conducting a death investigation which is standard procedure whenever a juvenile dies. On January 29, 2015, an autopsy was conducted which is also standard procedure. The juvenile's cause of death has been determined to be a homicide as result trauma. The victim has been identified as **Brianna Sandy**.

Two adults and three additional juveniles were in the home when the incident occurred. Child Protective Services has been notified and the children are currently being cared for by a relative. The investigation into the circumstances and motive remain under investigation. As more additional information becomes available, it will be released.
