Suspect Arrested in Robbery from Person Investigation: 1400 Block of Todds Lane

The Hampton Police Division has arrested, a **14-year-old Hampton male juvenile**, in connection with a robbery from person that occurred on March 10, 2015.

At 5:28 p.m., officers responded to Davis Middle School located in the 1400 block of Todds Lane in reference to a robbery from person. Upon arrival, officers discovered that a **14-year-old Hampton male** student that was attending an after school class displayed a knife and took a cell phone from the faculty member that was in the class. After taking the item, the student fled the classroom on foot. Another faculty member detained the student in a hallway until officers arrived. Once on scene officers arrested the suspect without further incident. Through the course of the investigation it was determined that there were no additional students or faculty members in the classroom when the incident occurred, that no one was injured and that this incident was gang related. The juvenile was charged with one count of robbery, one count possession of a weapon on school property and one count of gang participation. The student remains in custody at juvenile detention.
