## Youth Commission wants teens to take surveys about public transportation, financial smarts

March 9, 2016 - If you're a Hampton teenager in grades 9-12, the Hampton Youth Commission wants to know what you think about public transportation in Hampton - and how well city teenagers are prepared for the financial side of life as an adult.

In addition to being a voice for young people in Hampton - and possibly prompting a change in city policies - every teen who completes an online survey will be entered in a drawing to win a Chick-Fil-A gift card.
