Victim Identified in Homicide Investigation: 200 South Back River Road

The Hampton Police Division has identified the victim of a homicide that occurred on January 17, 2013 in the 200 block of South Back River Road.

At 11:02 p.m., the Hampton Police Division was notified that two victims were being treated for gunshot wounds at the Sentara Careplex. Upon officer's arrival, they discovered that two adult male victims were suffering from gunshot wounds to their upper body. **Kurtis Rashad Toombs**, a 25-year-old Hampton man, was pronounced deceased at local hospital on January 18, 2013 at 10:15 a.m., as a result of injuries that he sustained during this incident. The second victim, a 23-year-old Hampton man, sustained injuries that were non-life threatening. He has been treated and released from the hospital.

The preliminary investigation has revealed that the two victims were occupying a 2012 Chevy Malibu when they were shot by unknown suspect(s) in the 200 block of South Back River Road. After being shot, the victims drove themselves to the hospital for treatment. The motive is still under investigation and as further information becomes available it will be released.
