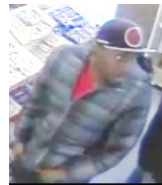

Suspect Sought in Stolen Vehicle Investigation: 100 Block of Doolittle Road

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect in possession of a stolen vehicle from the 100 block of Doolittle Road.

On February 9, 2013, Hampton Police responded to the 100 block of Doolittle Road in reference to a report of a stolen vehicle. The vehicle, a 1993 green Honda Accord displaying a Virginia license tag of (ZTC-7951) was last seen by the owner at approximately 10:00 p.m. on February 8, 2013 and was discovered stolen the following day at approximately 10:00 a.m.

At approximately 4:35 p.m. on February 9, 2013, the stolen vehicle was observed by an acquaintance of the owner at a business in the 2300 block of Shell Road. When the acquaintance approached the vehicle a suspect occupying the vehicle displayed a firearm and then fled in the stolen vehicle. The suspect is described as a black male, 5'06"-5'07", 140-160 pounds in his early twenties. The vehicle has not been recovered and the investigation is on-going.
