Robbery from Business Investigation: 2000 Block of Nickerson Boulevard

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect who is responsible for a robbery from business that occurred on May 6, 2013.

The investigation revealed that at 12:54 p.m., Hampton Communications received a complaint of a robbery from business from the Radio Shack, located in the 2000 block of Nickerson Boulevard. The investigation revealed that the suspect gave the clerk a note which implied that he had a firearm and demanded money. The suspect removed an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency and was last seen fleeing from the business on foot through the parking lot. No one was injured during the incident.

The suspect is described as a black male with a thin build, 6'1"-6'2", and was last seen wearing sunglasses, blue jeans, a white t-shirt with a long sleeve black shirt underneath and a large wig.
