Suspect Sought in Multiple Burglary Investigations

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in locating the suspect who has been identified in connection with multiple burglary investigations which occurred May 7, 2013 - May 17, 2013.

The suspect has been identified as **Brandon Wayne Milligan**, a 29-year-old Hampton man with a last known address in the 1700 block of North Mallory Street. He currently has warrants for Three counts of Burglary and Three counts of Grand Larceny. He is known to frequent areas of North King Street and Fox Hill Road.
