Update to Homicide Investigation: 1400 Block of West Queen Street

On June 5, 2013 at 11:19 p.m., Hampton Communications received multiple calls in reference to possible shots fired in the 1400 block of West Queen Street. Upon officer's arrival they located an individual who had suffered from a gunshot wound to the upper body in the parking lot of the 7-Eleven located at 1401 West Queen Street. Members of the Hampton Fire and Rescue Division responded to the scene and pronounced the victim deceased. The deceased has been identified as **Robert Jason Sheene**, a 27-year-old Hampton man.

The preliminary investigation has shown that Mr. Sheene and other known individuals got into a verbal altercation in the parking lot. During the altercation, firearms were brandished and Mr. Sheen was shot. The investigation thus far has identified **Marcus Antonio Pelham**, a 33-year-old Hampton man with a last known address in the first block of Davenport Court, as being present when the incident occurred. He has been arrested and charged with one count of Possession of a Firearm while in Possession of Narcotics, one count of Possession of Narcotics with the Intent to Distribute and one count of Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon. This incident has strong drug overtones. The investigation continues and as further information becomes available it will be released.
