Indictments Served in Homicide Investigation: 1400 Block of East Pembroke Avenue

On May 5, 2013, at 1:53 a.m., Hampton Communications received multiple W-911 calls in reference to a shooting at Jack's Restaurant, located in the 1400 block of East Pembroke Avenue. Officers, along with members of the Hampton Fire and Rescue Division, responded to the scene and located **Charlie Moses Woodbury**, a 27-year-old Hampton man, lying on the ground outside of the business suffering from a gunshot wound to the upper torso. He was transported to a local hospital with life threatening injuries and was pronounced deceased at 2:23 a.m.

The preliminary investigation revealed that the suspect and the victim had been in a verbal altercation with several subjects outside of the business when the suspect approached the victim displayed a firearm and shot the victim. On August 7, 2013, indictments were served on **Patrick Julius Roberts**, a 22-year-old Hampton man who resides in the 1200 block of Hale Drive, for one count of Murder, one count of Use of a Firearm in the Commission of a Felony and one count of Possession of a Firearm by Convicted Felon. Mr. Roberts is currently incarcerated in the Hampton City Jail on unrelated charges.
