Suspect Arrested in Bomb Threat Investigation: 1400 Block of West Queen Street

The Hampton Police Division has arrested **Chandon CJ Burton** in connection with a bomb threat that was made on October 3, 2013.

At 11:09 a.m., a student at Hampton High School advised School Administrators about a potential bomb threat. School Administrators immediately contacted the Hampton Police Division in reference to the threat. Due to the nature of threat, the school was placed on lock-down while the incident was investigated. The threat was quickly determined to be a hoax and the school resumed normal operations just after 12:00 p.m. As a result of the investigation, **Chandon CJ Burton**, an 18-year-old Hampton man and Hampton High School student has been arrested and charged with one count of Threatening to Bomb.

Threatening to Bomb is a class 5 felony which can carry a term of imprisonment of not less than one year nor more than 10 years, or in the discretion of the jury or the court trying the case without a jury, confinement in jail for not more than 12 months and a fine of not more than \$2,500, either or both.
