Robbery from Business Investigation: 3800 Block of Kecoughtan Road

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect who is responsible for a robbery from business that occurred on October 3, 2013.

The investigation revealed that at 8:31 p.m., Hampton Communications received an e911 call from an employee at the Mega Mart located in the 3800 block of Kecoughtan Road in reference to a robbery from business. The investigation revealed that the suspect entered the business, brandished a firearm and demanded money. After taking an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency from the business, the suspect fled on foot. He was last seen running westbound on Kecoughtan Road towards LaSalle Avenue. No one was injured during the incident. The suspect is described as a Black male, 5'08 to 5'10", 160 to 170 lbs., wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and dark pants.
