Robbery from Business Investigation: 200 block of Fox Hill Road

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect who is responsible for a robbery from business that occurred on October 8, 2013.

The investigation revealed that at 2:17 p.m., a suspect entered the Navy Federal Credit Union located in the 200 block of Fox Hill Road, displayed a firearm and demanded U.S. currency. After obtaining an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency the suspected fled from the business on a bicycle. No one was injured during the incident.

The suspect is described as a white male carrying a book bag, approximately 6'01" and was last seen wearing a white t-shirt over a long sleeve grey shirt and attempted to hide his identity by wearing a black ski mask.
