Multiple Larcenies from Vehicle Investigation

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect(s) responsible for multiple larcenies from vehicles which occurred in the Fox Hill section of the city.

On October 12, 2013, at approximately 7:40 a.m., officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Drummonds Way in reference to a vehicle larceny. While on scene, officer's quickly discovered that multiple vehicles in the Howe Road area, Willow Oaks neighborhood and Nickerson area were discovered to have been tampered with. The investigation revealed the suspect(s) rummaged through the vehicles and removed electronics, U.S. Currency, purses and wallets containing personal identifications. It appears that there was no forced entry into the vehicles and that most vehicles had been left unsecured. There is no suspect identification to provide at this time.

The Hampton Police Division encourages all citizens to secure their vehicles and to remove items of value from plain view from inside of their vehicle. The Division will have increased patrols in and around these areas to maintain a high visibility.

Crime Line callers remain anonymous and never appear in court. If a Crime Line call results in an arrest, the caller is eligible for a reward up to \$1,000.00.
