HAMPTON AQUATICS CENTER COMPETING PPEA PROPOSAL SOLICITATION

The City of Hampton, Virginia (“City”) hereby provides notice that it has accepted for further review an Unsolicited Proposal pursuant to the Public-Private Education Facilities and Infrastructure Act of 2002 (“PPEA”). The City has determined to accept this Unsolicited Proposal for conceptual phase consideration and in accordance with the PPEA will accept competing conceptual proposals for consideration that comply with the PPEA and the procedures adopted by the City. The proposed qualifying project is described as follows:

**Construction of an Aquatics Center**

**The Unsolicited Proposal contains an offer to construct a state-of-the-art Aquatics Center on a vacant parcel owned by the City at the corner of Pine Chapel Road and Coliseum Drive. It contemplates activities, including training and competition swimming, diving, water polo, and synchronized swimming. The design includes a lobby, locker rooms, a “wet” classroom, competition pool, program pool, and whirlpool. The Unsolicited Proposal is aligned with the City’s Strategic Priorities. Attached for additional information are two types of Aquatics Centers contemplated by City Council.**

The Unsolicited Proposal may be reviewed at the City’s Office of Consolidated Procurement at 1 Franklin Street, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Hampton, Virginia and the Clerk of Council’s Office at 22 Lincoln Street, 8<sup>th</sup> Floor, Hampton, Virginia during normal business hours 8:00 A.M. to 4:30p.m. Monday through Friday. Any party that may be interested in submitting a competing conceptual proposal may do so by following the procedures for Competing Proposals as outlined in the City of Hampton, Virginia Public-Private Education Facilities and Infrastructure Act of 2002 Guidelines (Rev.
