

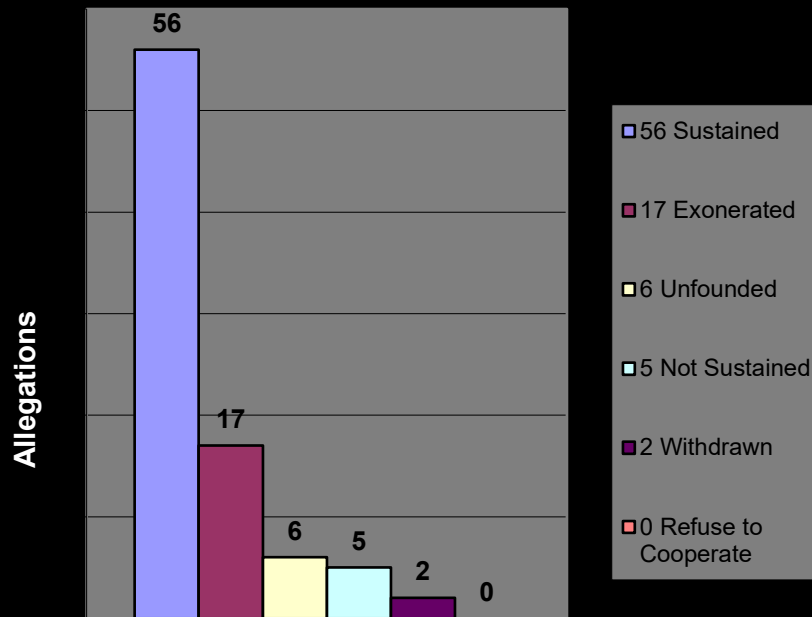


# FINDINGS CHART

2018 - 2020

2018

A total of 43 complaints were received in 2018. Of those 12 were citizen initiated and 31 were internal.



NOTE: Discrepancy between complaints received and allegations is accounted for by the fact that some cases involve more than one officer and/or more than one allegation.

### DEFINITION OF FINDINGS

**Sustained:** Misconduct is substantiated. Misconduct may be as stated in complaint or as a result of investigation.

**Exonerated:** Incident occurred, officer acted lawfully and properly.

**Unfounded:** Incident cited in complaint is falsely reported or not factual.

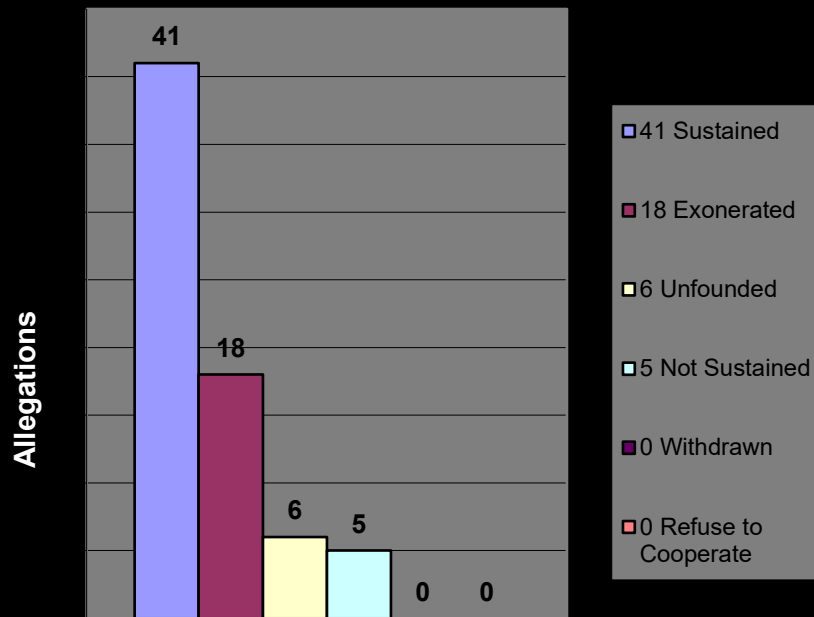
**Not Sustained:** Insufficient evidence exists to prove or disprove complaint.

2019

A total of 63 complaints were received in 2019. Of those 43 were citizen initiated and 21 were internal.

**Unfounded:** Incident cited in complaint is falsely reported or not factual.

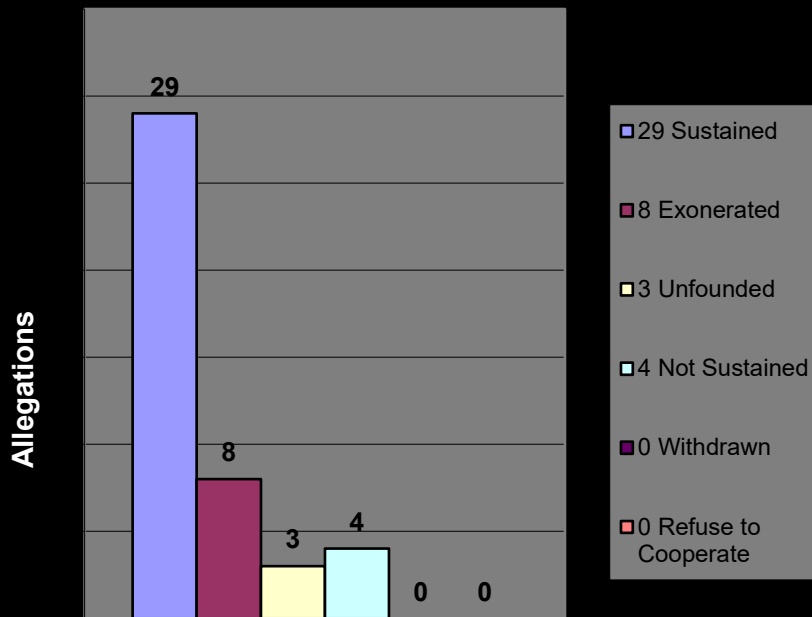
**Not Sustained:** Insufficient evidence exists to prove or disprove complaint.
